#### LEGISLATIVE;

The MOC bill, signed by the Governor on March 23<sup>rd</sup>, is being reviewed for any loop holes. They also voted on veterans plates for motorcycles. It also passed unanimously, and now awaits action by the Assembly.

The MRF is not supporting the new Bill HR 2414 (Black Box), this bill endorses "black boxes" in all vehicles, including motorcycles.

What do you do when an emergency\police vehicle or tow truck is stopped on the road? You must slow down and move over (if possible).




